The American Baptist Women are collecting for Church World Service hygiene kits.

They have decided this year to collect a few items each month instead of all of the items at once.

For the month of November, they are collecting Wide-tooth combs. They must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth. No pocket combs or picks. Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 6 inches of teeth.

Did you know that these kits are given out all over the world? Whenever disasters have destroyed people's homes, or disrupted their lives, CWS comes in and brings these kits. If you don't know much about CWS they also offer cleaning buckets with cleaning supplies, blankets, feminine hygiene kits, and other kits too.

ABW has chosen to support CWS through the hygiene kits.

BIBLE PUZZLE CHALLENGE



Enjoy the fun now and find the 16 Books!


Thank you to Heather Draper for the added fun this month!
